APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND ELECTRIC SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "Applicant") hereby applies for membership in and agrees to purchase electric energy from Southeastern Electric Cooperative, Inc. (hereinafter called the "Cooperative") upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The Applicant will deposit with the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00, which, if this application is accepted by the Cooperative, will be applied on and constitute the Applicant's membership fee.
2. The Applicant will, when electric energy becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the Premises described below and will pay therefore monthly at rates to be determined from time to time in accordance with the by-laws of the Cooperative; provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy to be furnished for industrial uses. The Applicant will pay a bill of at least \$_____ per month.
3. The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative, adhering strictly to the National Electric Safety Code. Applicant hereby agrees that \$3.12 of the amount paid for electricity each year is for a subscription to OKLAHOMA LIVING.
4. The Applicant will comply with, and be bound by, the provisions of the certificate of incorporation and by-laws of the Cooperative, and such rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by the Cooperative.
5. The Applicant, by making a deposit of the membership fee and upon acceptance of this application by the Cooperative, as a member assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that under the law his private property cannot be attached for any such Cooperative debts or liabilities.
6. It is agreed that the meter installation, poles, conductor, transformers, and all other appurtenances thereto, on the line side of and including the point of service delivery which is the meter installation, are the property of the Cooperative, and may be inspected, altered, serviced, changed out, removed or retired at any time by said Cooperative. It is further agreed that the Applicant will not and has no authority to authorize or permit anyone to disconnect, cut loose, interfere or tamper with any of the Cooperative's lines, services or equipment located on the Applicant's premises, which are the property of the Cooperative and that such property may be serviced, changed out or removed only by qualified employees of the Cooperative.
7. Member hereby assigns and transfers to the Cooperative the total book value of capital credits in Member's account which are available for retirement and agrees said amount shall become due and payable to the Cooperative one year after it has made a bona fide attempt to pay said amount and has not succeeded in doing so.

Notwithstanding anything herein contained, the Applicant expressly agrees that the Cooperative may terminate the electric service with or without notice for failing to pay for consumption of electricity in due time allotted. The acceptance of this application by the Cooperative shall constitute an agreement between the Applicant and the Cooperative and the contract for electric service shall continue in force so long as service is made available by the Cooperative to the Applicant under the terms and conditions herein specified, or until the Applicant informs the Cooperative in writing with thirty days prior notice that service is no longer desired; provided, however, that this instrument shall be executed by the Applicant, however, the Applicant shall not become a member until, and the Cooperative shall be bound by this application only, after this application has been approved and accepted by the Board of Trustees of the Cooperative and said application has been countersigned by the chairman of the Board of Trustees or duly authorized manager and attested by the secretary of the Cooperative.
