Energy Camp is a FREE *all-expense paid* adventure to Red Rock Canyon near Hinton, OK for a summer camp that is designed to help develop *leadership skills, have summertime fun, and at the same time be educated on one of rural America's most important industries – **rural electrification.*** The 2024 Energy Camp is set for May 28-May 31.
